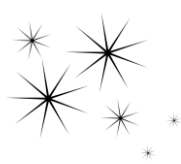

Peyote ring

Seed beads Miyuki:

0.5 grams

Seed beads 11°

SB11



0.5 grams

Seed beads 15°

SB15



Cylinder beads:

0.5 grams

Cylinder beads 11°

CB

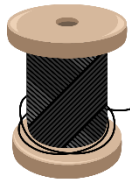

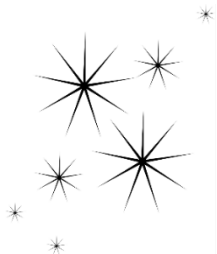
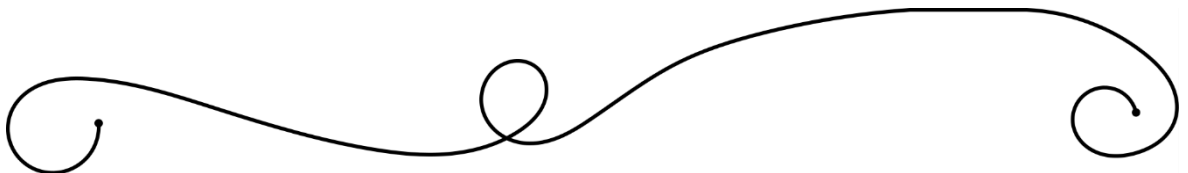

Step 1

Pick up 28xSB15 and go through the first couple of beads, this makes a circle.



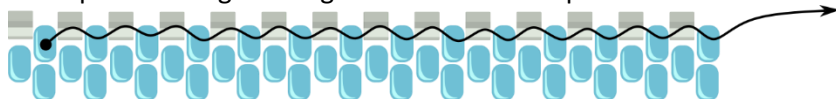
Step 2 (work the round in peyote technique)

Pick up 1xSB15, skip one SB15 and go through the next SB15. Repeat the entire round.



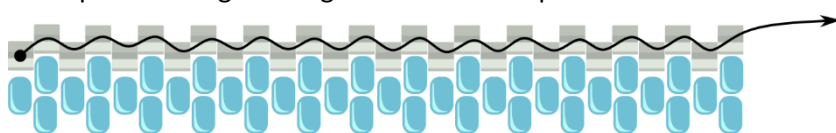
Step 3 (work the round in peyote technique)

Pick up 1xCB and go through the next SB15. Repeat the entire round.



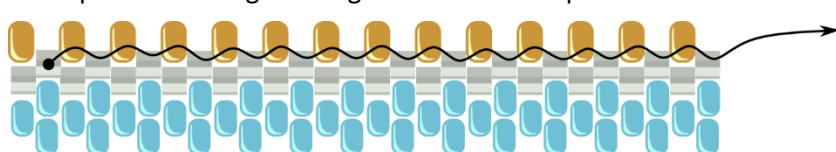
Step 4 (work the round in peyote technique)

Pick up 1xCB and go through the next CB. Repeat the entire round.



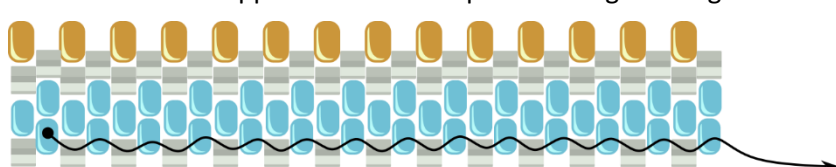
Step 5 (work the round in peyote technique)

Pick up 1xSB11 and go through the next CB. Repeat the entire round.



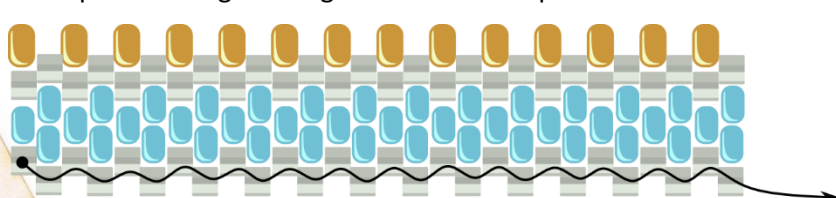
Step 6 (work the round in peyote technique)

Exit a SB15 at the opposite side. Pick up 1xCB and go through the next SB15. Repeat the entire round.



Step 7 (work the round in peyote technique)

Pick up 1xCB and go through the next CB. Repeat the entire round.



Step 8 (no extra beads in this round)

"Zip the 2 parts together." Go through the SB11 and CB (opposite sides). This closes the ring.

Step 9

Tie off the thread with half hitch knots.
