



"Heishi"





Supply list Heishi:

Heishi bracelet kit:





Pliers 2 pieces Scissors Beadstopper









Step 1

Use the 2 pliers to attach the 4 charms to the jumprings and close the jumrings.

Step 2

Cut the piece of elastic cord into 4 equal pieces.

Step 3

Attach the beadstopper to the first piece of elastic cord.

Stringing the beads

If you want to create a central pattern or symmetry, it is advisable to start with the beads you want to see in the center of your bracelet.

It is easier to visualize the final result. You can test this by adding or removing beads from each end of the wire without having to remove the entire length already strung. It is also convenient to adjust the length.







Step 4

If you have finished stringing the beads, add 1 bigger bead at the end to hide the knot. then tie a knot like this

Twist the right thread over the left thread three times (or vice versa) to intertwine them. Make sure that it is always the same wire that turns around the other.

Repeat the previous step to form a second loop above the first row.

Make a third loop as before, then tighten everything.

Cut the threads 1 mm from the knot and place a large-hole bead over it to conceal it or put a knot cover over it.

Tip: To solidify your knot, you can add a dot of jewelry glue or clear varnish.
